Club Stores

With the number of new members joining our club, I need to introduce you to our club stores. I have a few items on hand including one of the old style club shirts size XL for \$27 and a few ball caps for \$10. We have an Embroidery shop that will embroider the club logo on your shirt, or any other garment. Remember to check the colors in the logo so you don't pick a color that will make the embroidery blend into the garment. They also have shirts available at the embroidery shop. A standard size club logo is \$6 if you purchase one of the shirts at the shop, \$8 if you use your own. A minimum charge is \$15 so best bet is to bring 2 items.
